1. Review the Meeting Minutes on March 22nd, 2006.

a. Meeting Minutes Approval

The meeting minutes on March 22nd 2006 have been approved, suggested by Ken and seconded by Heiko.

b. Information on minute 3d.

Heiko wanted to know if the draft regarding syntax in BNF format is already available to be revised. The draft is available and was presented by Adam Ley previously.

3. PAR Application

The discussion was based on the information in 2006 IEEE Standard Association Meeting Schedule (2006calendar.pdf), in the guideline to fill up the PAR application form for the revision of a standard (parrevstd.ppt), and the initial information notes (info_par_app.doc) that have been sent out before the meeting. Below are the results:

- c. Section 9: The official reporter will be the chairman.
- d. Section 11: Sponsor Balloting Information.

 - The expected date of submission for initial sponsor ballot is Jan. 30th, 2007.

- e. Section 12: The projected completion date for submittal to RevCom is Oct. 30th, 2007.
- d. Sections 13 (Scope of proposed project), section 14 (Purpose of proposed project) and section 15 (Reason for the proposed project) will be reviewed. Ken will provide more information on ABSDL, Adam Ley will provide information on non-ABSDL issue and Adam Cron suggesting to include a statement to allow minor correction during the course of the PAR.

4. Other Issues

- a. A paper regarding power pin monitoring from Philips has been sent out by Ken for the group information. With this information, the ABSDL development will not provide specific support for power pin monitoring application.
- b. Some information in the paper that has been submitted to ITC will be updated, if accepted.
